Procdeure & Investigation

We began our investigation with a tour of the property. We performed baseline sweeps for EMF in all areas of the Courthouse. While doing the walk through, we also took several pictures. After our initial walk through, we proceeded to set up all of the equipment throughout the 3 stories. Several EVP sessions as well as Estes sessions were performed. Throughout the 3 floors, we experienced several K2 hits, Rem pod hits, and Trip Wire hits. Our cameras recorded loud noises and dragging sounds in the Hanging Room when no one was on that floor. During the Estes sessions, we experienced several appropriate one-word answers to our questions.

CONCLUSION

Louisiana Spirits has investigated many reportedly active locations in the state. By not simply relying on haunted tales, we treat any location as the next potential active location. In some cases, we walk out empty-handed, other times we do not.
